An additional charge of \$63 per semester hour will be assessed for all Engineering courses.

An additional charge of \$97.00 per credit hour, with the exception of 100, 500, and 600 level courses, will be assessed for Undergraduate Business Courses.

An additional charge of \$130.00 per credit hour will be assessed to specific College of Nursing Courses.

An additional charge of \$107 per credit hour will be assessed for all Architecture and Design Courses

Students will pay the per credit hour rate times the number of hours registered.

The minimum charge is equivalent to one hour at the semester hour rate.

Some departments charge a Special Course Fee. Examples: Engineering, Chemistry, Physical Education, Music, Art, Nursing, College of Business, College of Social work, etc. Please check with the department for the specific course fee.

An additional charge of \$46 per credit hour will be assessed to Distance Education students

All fees are subject to any changes approved by the Board of Trustees prior to the beginning of a term.
